It’s a fun, creative, and confidence-building experience where kids learn teamwork, problem-solving, and the excitement of running their own business.

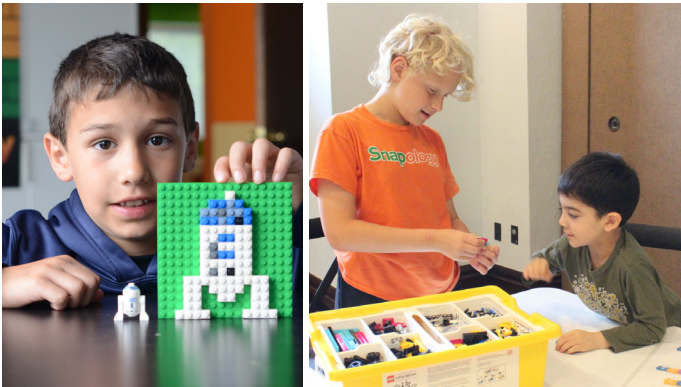
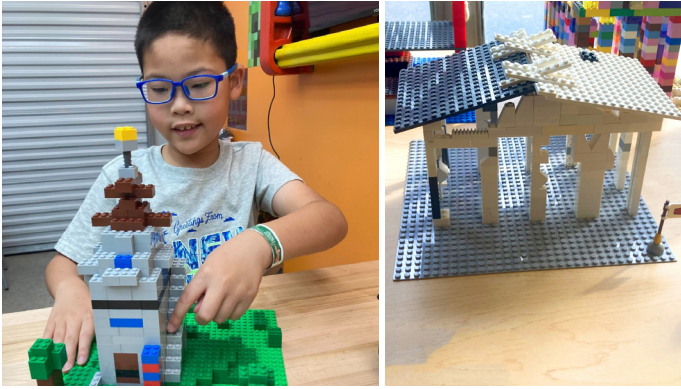
